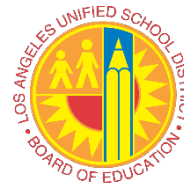

Q 9 Behavioral Health

- A. Screening/assessment, referral, or treatment of behavioral health issues
- B. Prescribe and/or manage behavioral health medications

Q 10 Oral Health

- A. Oral health services provided to individuals by the health center
