- ▣ Support Staff from TSFC: Nurse Manager/Clinic Manager/Director of Nursing

- ▣ (1) Routine General Medical Examination
- ▣ (2) Routine Infant or Child Health Check
- ▣ (3) Barrier Contraceptive, Maintenance
- ▣ (4) Oral Contraceptive, Evaluation
- ▣ (5) Barrier Contraceptive, Initial

# A FEW STATS (Cont'd)

## RACE:

▣ African Americans:	14%
▣ Asian & PI:	7%
▣ Hispanic:	66%
▣ Mixed & Others:	6%
▣ Native Americans:	1%
▣ White:	6%

# OTHER INFO

- ▣ Students can access services via walk-ins or appointments
- ▣ School Nurse refers & confers with the Pediatric Fellow
- ▣ Behavioral Health Services provided by Master Level Students pursuing their PhD
- ▣ Behavioral Health Interns generally complete a 1 year Internship

# OTHER INFO (Cont'd)

- ▣ Kaiser Pediatric Fellow—Stays only 1 year
- ▣ Eligibility Services are provided to parents, primarily for Medi-Cal
