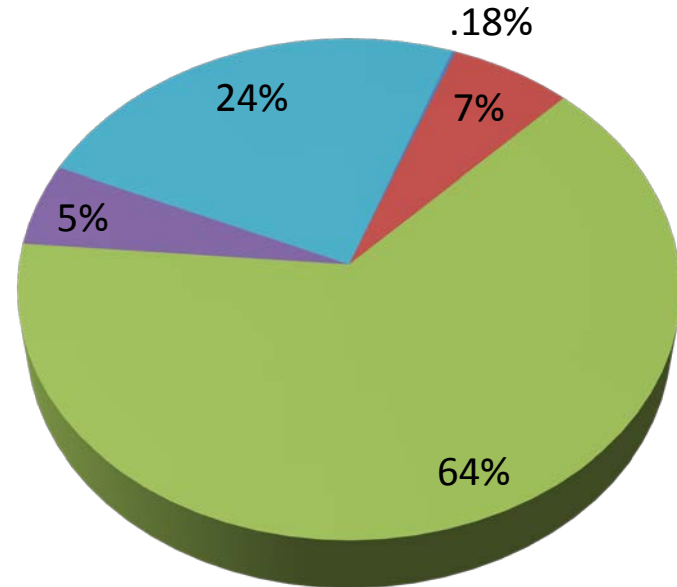

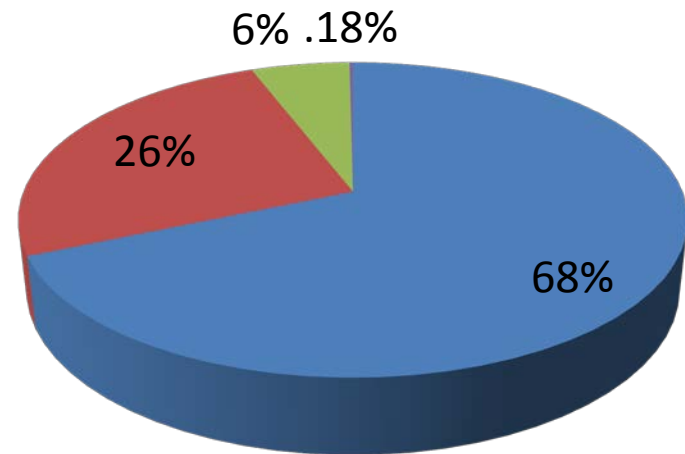

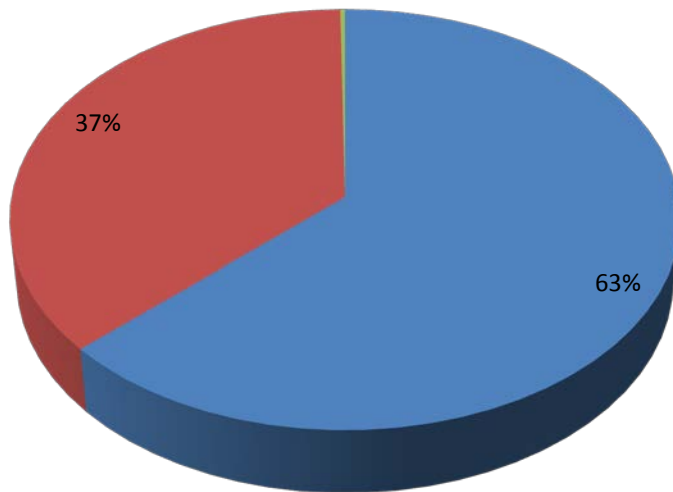

July – December 2011

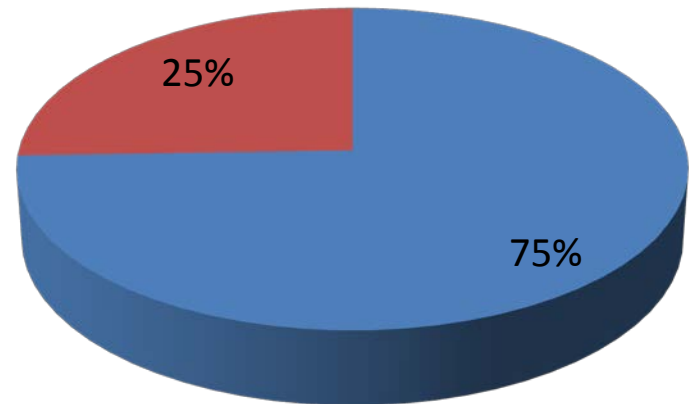
■ Female ■ Male

Teen Popular Opinion Leader Program

- P.O.L. program was a friends–educating–friends program where female student volunteers learned how to incorporate HIV prevention messages into casual conversations.
- Basic elements:
 - Share the message about HIV/AIDS
 - Increase condom use
 - Reduce the number of sexual partners

140 participants made 1,370 contacts over 3 years!

EPICS PROGRAM

Program Goal

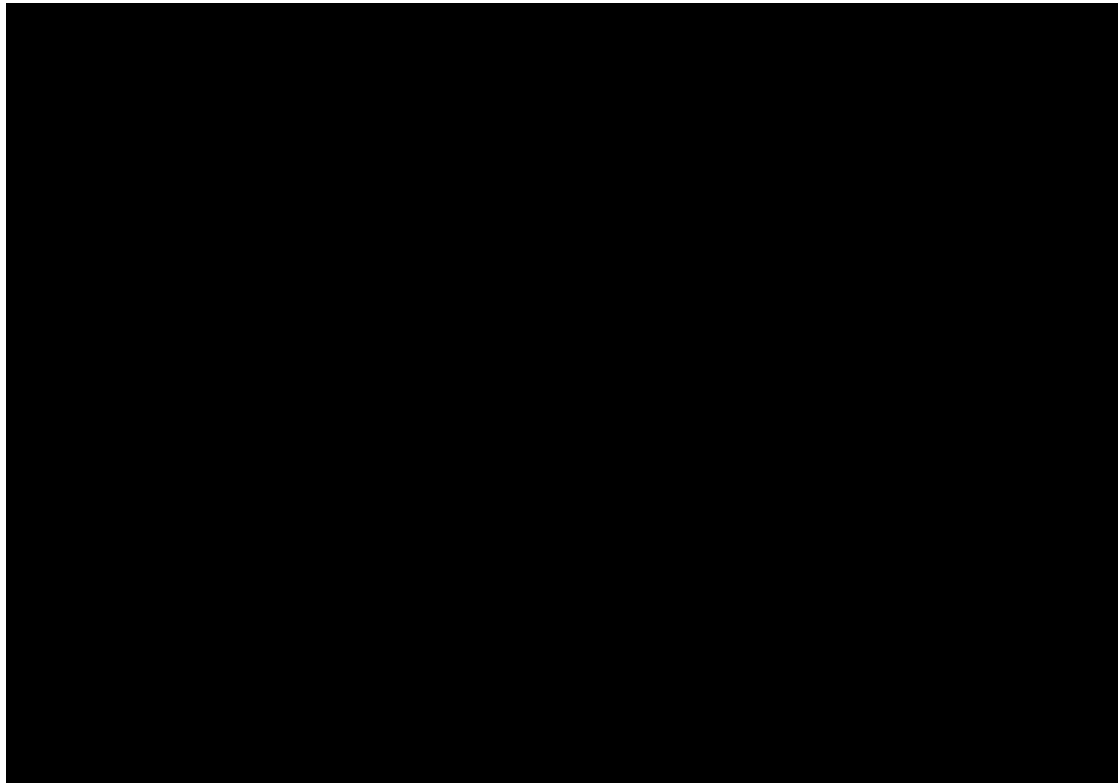
- The overall goal of the EPICS Program was to increase access to chlamydia and gonorrhea screening for females 25 years and under as part of a broader family planning program.

Program Objectives

- Outreach
 - Held four lunch time events with DJ and give-aways
- Chlamydia Screening
 - 792 students tested
 - 93% female, 7% male
 - 5.5% positivity rate

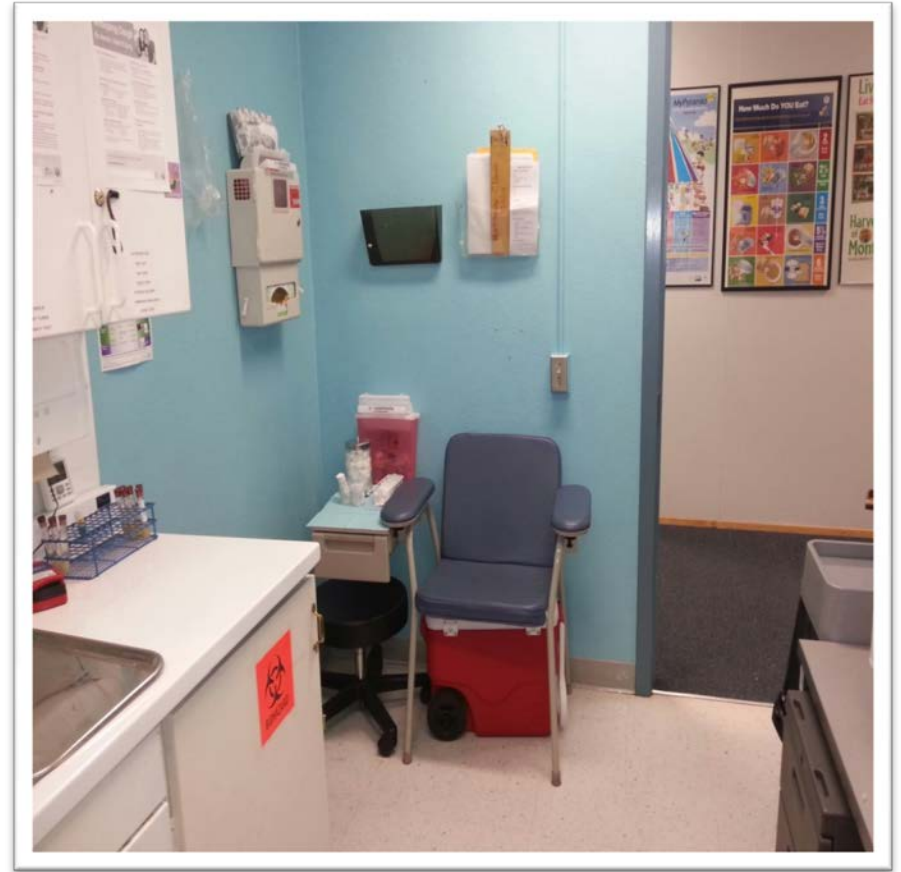
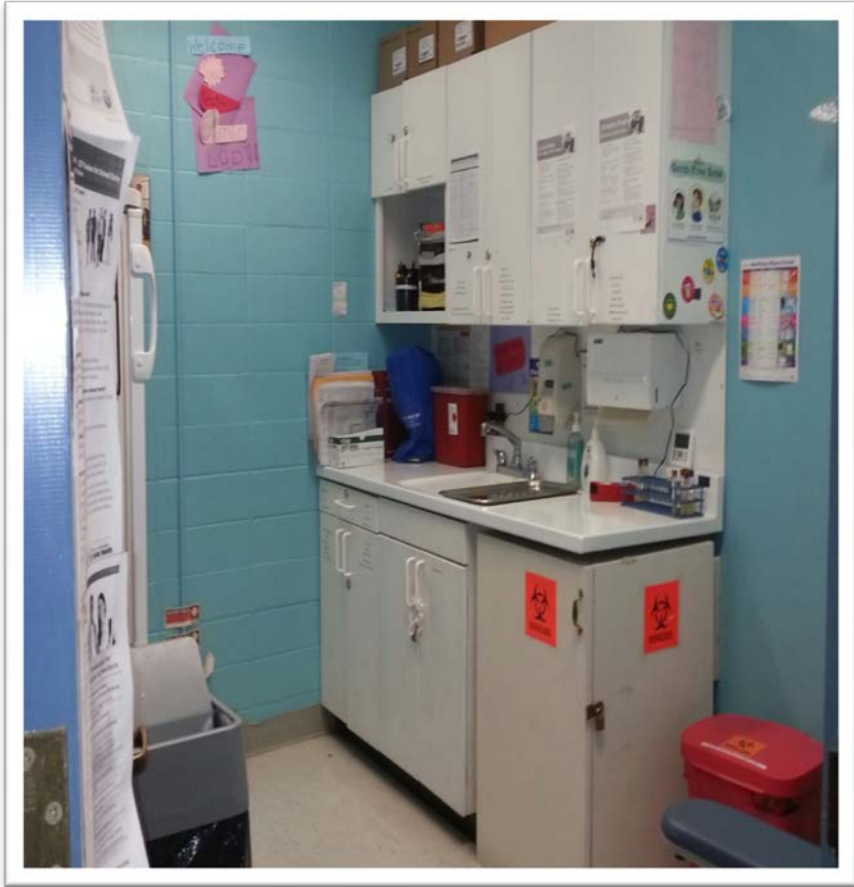
EPICS student volunteers created 3 in-house PSAs which was played on Kennedy High School weekly broadcast.

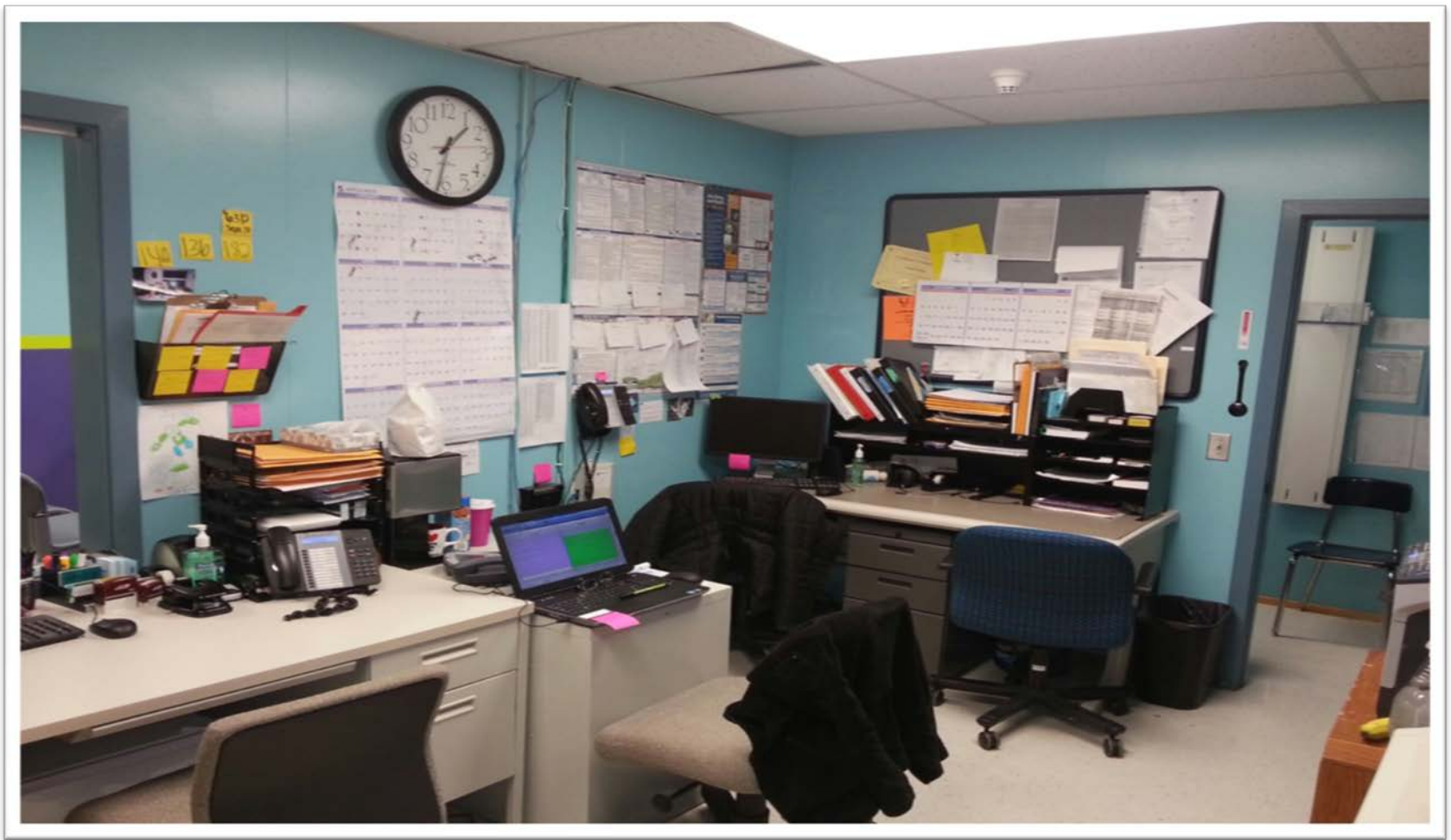
